A Republic

MUTUAL ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the parties hereto recognize the real likelihood that fires or other like disasters hereafter occurring in their respective territories could reach such proportions that it would be impossible to control them with local equipment and personnel, and to facilitate and comply with the 1970 Oregon State Fire Service Plan as directed by Executive Order No. 01-070-12 under ORS 476.519 to 476.610 of the Oregon State Emergency Conflagration Act, and it is necessary and proper that a Mutual Assistance Agreement be entered into by the undersigned for the mutual protection of life and property; now, therefore,

IN CONSIDERATION of the covenants herein contained, each of the undersigned agrees to furnish fire-fighting equipment and personnel to any of the other undersigned, when assistance is necessary and men and equipment are available, and to receive and transmit such calls as may be received from the police or fire departments of any and all of the undersigned when authorized by, and transmitted in accordance with, the regulations of the Federal Communications Commission; provided, however, that no party hereto shall be held liable for any failure, commission, or omission in connection with the receiving or transmission of such calls. It is agreed that none of the parties hereto shall be liable to any other party for damage to property, loss of equipment, of injury to personnel, or for the payment of any compensation whatsoever, arising in the course of, or as a result of, any assistance or lack of assistance rendered under the terms of this agreement. The administrative heads of the fire departments of the parties to this agreement are authorized and directed to meet and draft such Rules of Procedure as shall best accomplish the purposes of this agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, each of the undersigned has caused this agreement to be signed by its duly authorized officers the day and year hereinafter indicated in connection with each such party. This document shall supersede and repeal all previous mutual aid agreements entered into by the undersigned as of December 1, 1974,

TO: Parties to the 1975 Mutual Assistance Agreement for Firefighting in Jackson County

The State Forestry Department is in complete accord with the purpose and intent of the 1975 Mutual Assistance Agreement. Further, the Department will participate fully in this cooperative effort.

However, this instrument has not been signed by the State Forester upon advice of the Attorney General. Specifically, the problem is concerned with the "hold harmless" clauses found in the second paragraph of the Agreement which reads as follows:

"It is agreed that none of the parties hereto shall be liable to any other party for damage to property, loss of equipment, of injury to personnel or for the payment of any compensation whatsoever, arising in the course of, or as a result of, any assistance or lack of assistance rendered under the terms of this agreement."

It is the opinion of the Attorney that the State cannot legally deny the rights of its employes to bring claims for personal injury. Therefore, we are suggesting that this letter be attached to the Mutual Assistance Agreement in lieu of signature so that parties thereto are advised that the Department plans to fully participate in this excellent cooperative venture.
