## MUTUAL ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the parties hereto recognize the real likelihood that fires or other like disasters hereafter occurring in their respective territories could reach such proportions that it would be impossible to control them with local equipment and personnel, and it is necessary and proper that a Mutual Assistance Agreement be entered into by the undersigned for the mutual protection of life and property; now, therefore,

IN CONSIDERATION of the covenants herein contained, each of the undersigned agrees to furnish fire-fighting equipment and personnel to any of the other undersigned, when assistance is necessary and men and equipment are available, and to receive and transmit such calls as may be received from the police or fire departments of any and all of the undersigned when authorized by and transmitted in accordance with, the regulations of the Federal Communications Commission; provided, however, that no party hereto shall be held liable for any failure, commission, or omission in connection with the receiving or transmission of such calls. It is agreed that none of the parties hereto shall be liable to any other party for damage to property, loss of equipment or injury to personnel, or for the payment of any compensation whatsoever, arising in the course of, or as a result of, any assistance or lack of assistance rendered under the terms of this agreement. The administrative heads of the fire departments of the parties to this agreement are authorized and directed to meet and draft such rules of procedure as shall best accomplish the purposes of this agreement.

The administrative heads of the Fire Departments of the parties to this agreement are authorized and directed to meet and draft such rules of procedure as shall best accomplish the purposes of this agreement.
