## Purpose

To establish an organizational structure and operating guidelines for the mobilization of Jackson and Josephine County fire service resources under the Oregon State Fire Marshals Fire Service Mobilization Plan.

## Policy

It shall be the policy of the Rogue Valley Fire Chiefs Association to comply with the requirements set forth in the Fire Service Mobilization Plan. The RVFCA under the direction of the Fire Defense Board Chiefs will coordinate regional readiness in accordance with the Fire Service Mobilization Plan including preparedness, resource configuration, leadership, systems for requesting and sending resources, and representation in state level policy making.

Specific direction for regional mobilization resources is to be done in compliance with the most recently approved Fire Service Mobilization Plan. While it is the role of the Fire Defense Board Chiefs to assist in coordination of regional resources and processing mobilization resource assistances, it is the individual Fire Chiefs responsibility to maintain working knowledge of the Fire Service Mobilization Plan and determine their agencies availability to commit resources as specified in the plan.
